<u>Letter from our President</u>

In Florida we are somewhat at the mercy of insurance companies when setting our budget.

Insurance coverage is our largest expenditure. There are only a few insurance companies that will cover beach front property in Florida. We work closely with an Insurance broker to get the best coverage from the most financially stable Insurance Companies.

The only other recourse for reducing our insurance cost is to reduce our risk. We have added plants to secure our beach from flood erosion. In doing so we have reduced our risk. The modification to the FEMA flood plan will lower our insurance premium.

We are in the final phase of this revision and we hope to lower our flood insurance by about \$35,000 per year.

In less than 90 days we should have the revised report and flood map from FEMA. Once we have the revised report we will once again contact our insurance providers and request a reduction in our premiums.

Parking Challenges

We have a problem with unauthorized cars parked on our lot. Last year we purchased and posted three signs warning people about unauthorized parking on our property. If you see a car arrive and people go directly to the beach please remind them our lot is for our residents. It is not enough for someone to know a name and unit number they must actually be there to visit that person.

If you have friends or relatives who would like to go to the beach and use our parking **they must** actually visit your unit. If they are not coming to visit you, they must use the Public Beach Parking (access point #10) south of our property.

We chose Bay Cedars because of their hearty nature and the fact that they will spread out and stay relatively short as they mature, keeping our long term maintenance costs in mind. We planted 150, 15 gallon Bay Cedar bushes.

Once a quarter we will trim the bushes to help maintain our view and help the bushes "fill out" and offer even more protection to our beach.

buttons covered so we can clean and sanitize the panel without causing damage to the electronics.


Summit Broadband:
